This one-story structure has a gable roof and rustic siding. The cornice is boxed. Windows are double-hung. The front porch has a hip roof with exposed rafter tails supported by plain posts and a crossed rail balustrade. The porch and placement of the current front door may not be original. To one side is a shed roofed addition.

SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)
The Maacama School house, so named for nearby Maacama Creek and Maacama Mountains, which now serves as a residence, was built prior to 1877 on the property of California pioneer, Franklin Bedwell. Bedwell donated land for the Maacama School. School records on file at the Museum date 1878-1916.
This simple structure, though somewhat altered, is typical of the early school structures in the area.
