This 1½ story house has a centered front gable and open gabled ends. In the rear is a shed roofed addition. The cornice is closed and the siding is channel rustic. The front gable is closed with a small, square window surrounded by cut shingles. Windows are double-hung with some being multi-paned and/or having molded caps. The front porch has a shed roof with chamfered and bracketed posts.

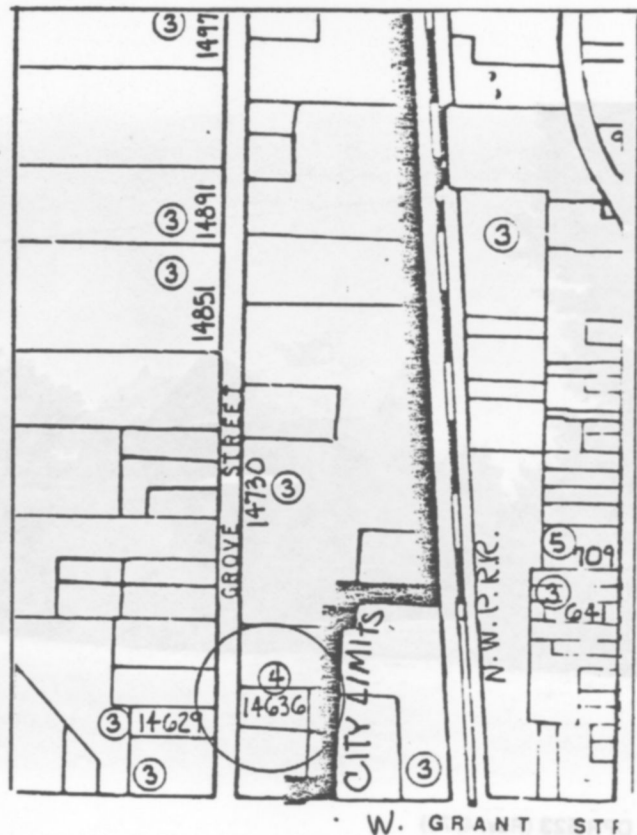
SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)
 This residence was at one time used as a barn for an orchard and residence at 95 West Grant (089-130-13-2). Originally part of a larger ranch known as "Hassett's Grove," this parcel was purchased by M.B. Baker of Oakland in 1889. He retired here and cultivated the fruit crop until his death in 1893. He was survived by his wife, Mattie.
 This structure is a typical example of outbuilding recycling, having been converted at an early period into a residence.
