This square hip roofed bungalow sports a front dormer w/ towered vent and hip roof. There is a boxed cornice above a plain freeze. To the left of the front gable is a 3 windowed slanted bay. A recessed veranda is found on the front left corner. The windows are double hung & occur in groups of 3 in some places. The house siding is narrow lap rustic, vertical boards covering the foundation. The foundation & house levels are defined by a plain belt course. Interesting details are fluted pilasters on the front corners, molded caps above the windows, and columns w/ Ionic capitals on the veranda balustrade. Very Similar to 002-271-23 (417 Haydon St.)
