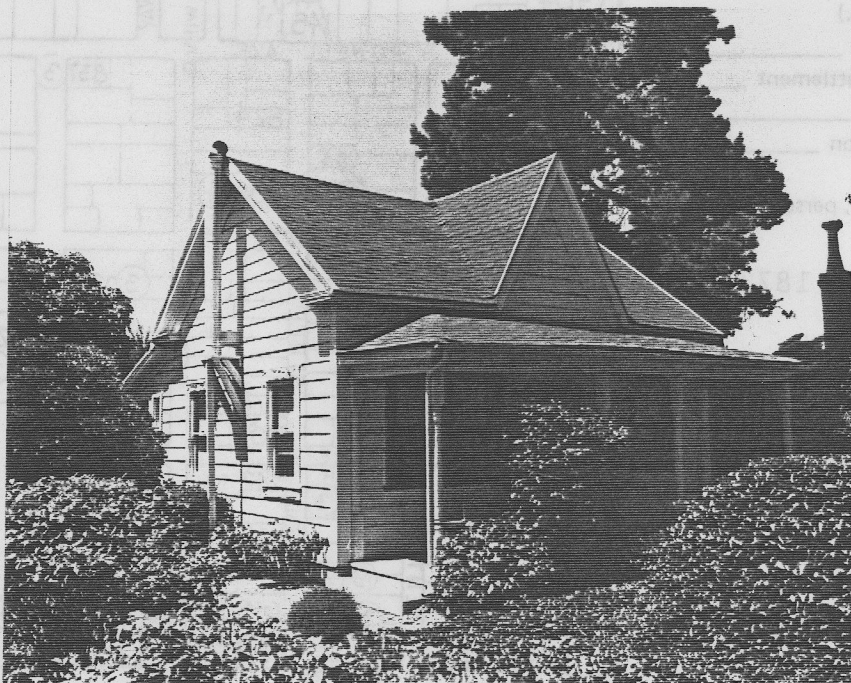

A small open gabled cottage with a steep gable centered over the entry door, it has double hung windows and is covered in rustic siding. The small hip-roofed porch is supported by turned columns and a later non-conforming balustrade system has been added. There has been a later shed-roofed addition to the rear.

E.F. "Ed" Adamson, about whom little is known, was the original owner in the early 1870's. Later the home was occupied by the Rev. J.C. Burgess who was the pastor of the Presbyterian church from 1900 to 1903.
