A rectangular 1½ story home with open gable ends and channel rustic siding. The cornice is boxed and windows are double-hung. The front appears to have had some alteration such as the current placement of the front door and the addition of used brick below the window level. The hipped roof front porch has bracketed, turned posts, and a railing with turned balusters. The metal stair railing is not original.
