ROUTES and RATES

As shown on map, all highways lead to either Healdsburg or Geyserville. Autoists turn to left one mile north of either town.

Wonderful scenic roads twenty-four feet wide all the way to Skaggs Springs.

Autoists coming from the north via Cloverdale turn to right at Sign Post before reaching Asti. Excellent road nine miles to Skaggs Springs.

Two trains daily from San Francisco via Sausalito Ferry to Geyserville, where Auto Stage connects for Skaggs Springs. Special 15 day round trip ticket sold only on Saturdays and Sundays, which includes stage fare, \$5.60.

Threemonthsround trip ticket \$6.20.

Rates—American Plan, \$29.50 per week and upwards, \$4.00 to \$5.00 per day. Special rates for children.

Rates include baths, swimming, tennis, boxball, dancing and other amusements usually charged for at most resorts.

Wonderful mineral waters and hot velvet baths that have no equal in all the world.

They are strongly recommended for rheumatism, lumbago, indigestion, stomach, liver, kidney and nervous troubles.

The waters range in temperature from 125 to 135 degrees and come boiling out of the sandstone absolutely pure.

Special hot and steam rooms are provided for ladies and gentlemen, with masseur and masseuse in attendance.

For those who prefer cool or luke-warm baths the waters are run into cooling tanks direct from the hot springs.

There are also cold springs of pure mountain water and of sulphur and iron that are refreshing and invigorating.

Outdoor swimming is a very healthful exercise if the water is pure.

At Skaggs Springs the water flows in a pipe line direct from the springs to the concrete swimming tank, and with the abundant supply of pure mineral water, cleanliness is assured.
