7b. Briefly describe the present *physical description* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This home is basically square w/a hip roof sporting hipped dormers on each side. In the front & rear is a slanted bay w/a sloped hood resting on 2 large sawn brackets. Above each bay is a slightly flared closed gable with a small window. The cornices are boxed & the freize is plain. Window are single panes or double hung some having upper sashes w/a diamond pattern. Bay & dormer windows have plain frames while the other openings have molded caps. 7 Tuscan columns are found on the solid balustrade of the receassed, wrap around veranda. Narrow lap rustic siding is used for the walls, foundation, gables & balustrade. Other features of this home are an exterior chimney & pendant lamps on the veranda.
