The main section of this house is one-story high with a gable roof and a dormer on each side. Extending from the main structure is a flat roofed porch over a lower level. Cornices on the structure are boxed and the gables have small blocks resembling rafter tails. Windows are double-hung and the exterior is covered with shingles. Shingles also cover the balustrade which has round columns. There are also some large, full-length, round columns. Off one end of the house is a pergola.

SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.) This house was built in 1879 by M.C. Bailey as his ranch hand quarters. M.C. Bailey, born in Illinois in 1836, farmed in Iowa from 1855 to 1874. On his arrival to Sonoma County in 1874, he became caretaker of Alexanders 1,000 acre ranch in Alexander Valley. In 1879 he purchased the William Mulligan farm of 163 acres. M.C. Bailey is most remembered as a contract threshing operator, serving all the farms in the Alexander Valley area.
