

A very small, single story gabled house that is constructed of Channel rustic siding, with boxed cornices and plain corner boards. The open gables have small returns. The entrance is in the gable end of the structure next to a large window which may not be original. Across the front and down one side is a hipped roof verandah with simple square posts and a single rail balustrade.

Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.) he unpretentious building at 214A Center Street has the honor of being he first meeting house of the first Seventh-day Adventist Church organzed West of the Rockies. Pioneer evangelists, Elders J. N. Loughborough and D.T. Bourdeau, commenced their tent meetings on June 10, 1869, and y August, 35 persons requested the formation of a church in Healdsburg. Ider J. N. Loughborough, on November 5, 1869, organized the Healdsburg eventh-day Adventist Church, with the believers in the town of Santa osa following on Nov. 12, 1869. Services continued at this church-owned ocation (E.W. Ruldolph propery - 1867 Assrs.) until August 17, 1871, hen the church body moved into their new 30 x 40 ft. building, seating 00, which had been built on the donated lot of Cornelius Bice at 331-35 North Street. E.W. Hendrick bought the Center Street property the ay the Adventists moved into their new church. From this small beginning, hurch membership in the Pacific State has grown to 142,830 with 526 organzed Churches.
