Gothic Revival

7b. Briefly describe the present *physical appearance* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

1½ story wood frame structure with center gable roof. West entrance porch with repeating center gable is a post 1911 alteration. Two sets of paired windows on each side porch, one double hung window in front center gable. Recessed structural opening for entrance and transom.

3 brick chimneys with projecting border blow rims. Rear shed portion with north facing porch is original. Gable end returns on sides. Channel rustic siding of redwood.

Originally had shed porch extending across front. That porch replaced with Italianate porch, and in 1940's with present porch. Building restored in 1984 after 1982 fire.
