This small cottage has a hip roof with ventilating dormer in front and a small hip roofed "L" forming the porch roof. The rafter tails are exposed and decoratively sawn to add a slight upward flare to the eave line. The exterior walls are also flared at the water table. The entire exterior is shingled including the porch and stair balustrade system. Turned columns support the porch roof. There is a small cantilevered bay window on the corner of the building.
