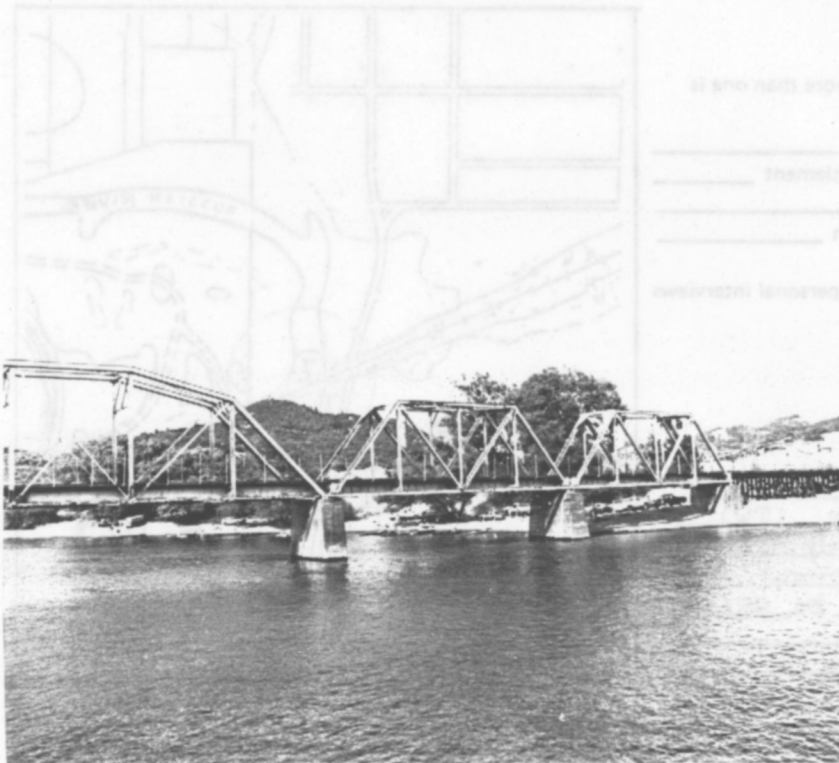

SIGNIFICANCE

This railroad bridge was constructed in December 1900 and January 1901. It replaced an original bridge, built in 1871, at the time that the Northwestern Pacific Railroad was extended north from Santa Rosa. Built during the era of railway pre-eminence in transportation, this bridge represents both an economic necessity and an historic link to nearby urban centers, as well as a visual landmark.
