A one-story house with a gable roof and rustic siding. There are two side additions and a hip-roofed porch across the front. The rafter tails are exposed and the open gable has a vent. The windows are double-hung except for a few which are sliding aluminum. In front, the windows are hung in pairs on either side of the centrally placed front door. The front porch has plain posts and no balustrade.
