

This hip roof cottage has a angled front bay and rectangular side bay with gable roofs over. The main cornice is boxed with sawn brackets and the gables filled with cut shingles. The angled bay has a decorative frieze and various sawn and turned ornaments. The verandah which wraps the front and side is original but posts and balustrade system has been altered.
