## DESCRIPTION

- 7a. Architectural style: Non-specific/Victorian Dutch Colonial
- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical appearance* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This is a two story cottage which has a jerkin head roof or clipped gables at the front and east side. The two-story porch is original to the structure and once wrapped around the west front corner of the building. The upper story has higher ceilings than the lower story, making the former the main living area in a style sometimes called, "piano nobile". Gable end has a round ventilator with molded surround that copies the lines of the truncated gable end. The cornices are boxed and the frieze plain. This siding is channel rustic with end boards. A shed roof rectagular bay extends on west side. The windows are double hung with two-on-two panes and plain surrounds. The upper story porch has plain rail balustrade and 4 x 4 pillars with curved braces above thin square capitals. The lower story porch are 6 x 6 posts.
