The two-story Chamber of Commerce Building, built in 1936 in the Mediterranean style, has a sloping front parapet of ceramic tiles and is faced in stucco. A balcony with turned post balustrade and heavy brackets extends across the second story tall French doors. The shop window and entrance door on the main level are recessed behind tall arches.
