

This one-story home has front and side gables and boxed cornices. The siding is channel rustic. The front gable has a pair of arched double-hung windows flanked by vents. Above the windows is a molded arch. Other windows are double-hung with molded caps and sill blocks. Across the front is a hip-roofed porch which has been screened in. It has exposed rafter tails, tapered square columns and a solid balustrade. The front door is flanked by sidelights.

SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)

This home was built in 1884 by August Thormann, a native of Germany, born in 1835. Little is known about Thormann besides the fact that he ranched here a number of years, before moving to Healdsburg, and had 25 acres of some of the earlier vineyards (1893) in Alexander Valley. He died at his home on Matheson Street in Healdsburg in 1918.

This structure typifies various detailing, such as window arches to adorn a simple rural residence.
