

DESCRIPTION

- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical description* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

Designed by Herbert & Caulkins, Architects in 1934, this Tudor Revival stucco home has steep gables, shallow bays and a large Tudor chimney decorated with a wrought iron tie-rod. Some of the tall multi-paned windows are topped with sculpted lintels. A few doors up the street at 726 Johnson is a more simple example of the same style built in 1925. This smaller home has narrow-clapboard siding and bands of tall narrow casement windows.

While there are a number of contractor built "tudor" style houses in the area, this house definately shows the hand of an architect in its lines and detailing.

This graceful home was built in 1934 by John Pordon and his brother Amedeo Pordon both well-know and prosperous contractors in Healdsburg. The architects were Herbert and Caulkins from Santa Rosa. The house is now owned by Letitia Clement the daughter of John Pordon.
