This large two-story Victorian residence has a truncated hip roof on the main volume and gabled deep bay in front. The cornice is boxed and decorated (recently) with cut scallops. The windows are tall narrow double-hung and often paired. A one story bay with banded windows has been added to one side and a porch that wraps the front and side is a later addition.
