This Queen Anne Cottage, built in 1900, has a truncated hip-roof, tall narrow windows and a wrap around veranda with geometric balustrade and turned pillars. The entrance door has a pedimented glass panel above wood panels. The gable ends have fish scale shingles, sunburst brackets and small stained glass windows.
