

- 7b. Briefly describe the present physical description of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This small one story cottage has a hip and gable roof with a plain boxed cornice. The square bay under the gable has a multi-paned sash with colored glass. The gable is filled with cut shingles and has turned buttons in the frieze below. A small entry porch has turned columns with sawn brackets supporting the hip roof. The open balustrade system is a later replacement. The entry door is recessed in a small paneled vestibule and the siding is channel rustic.

SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)

This small cottage uses a number of decorative items such as the turned buttons, sawn brackets and gable brace and turned columns and paneled entry to give it its Queen Anne styling.

This home was built circa 1895 by Benjamin H. Barnes who is most notable for his career in City and County law enforcement. Son of William Barnes, who opened the first shoe store in Healdsburg in 1879 and served a nine year term as mayor, Benjamin took over his father's shoe business in 1894, but made a career change to real estate in 1907. Barnes was City Marshall from 1909 to 1912 when he resigned to take a position in the Healdsburg National Bank. By 1918 however he was elected county under Sheriff. He lived in this home until he died.
