7b. Briefly describe the present physical description of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

A one-story, rectangular cottage with a hipped roof and dormer. The exposed rafters have curved tails and frieze on the main structure is slightly flared and covered with cut shingles. Windows are double-hung and occur singly or in pairs. They are capped by an architrave with a molded cap that runs around the entire structure. In the dormer are three small double-hung windows. The recessed front porch has round columns atop a solid balustrade. Lap rustic siding is used for the walls and balustrade.
