This 1 3/4 story house with gabled roof, has open gables which are sheathed in rustic siding, as is the balance of the house. The double hung windows have a small cap molding over them and are placed singly and in pairs around the structure. The cornice is boxed with sawn brackets and has curved constructed barge of shingles. The small front verandah has turned columns with brackets with a sawn and molded balustrode. The porch roof has a gable with vertical siding filling in and a shingled barge.
