The roof of this single-gable, two-story bungalow covers the recessed verandah and sports a shed-roofed dormer with three windows. Rafter ends are exposed and open brackets support the large rafter. The windows are double-hung and occur singly and in pairs on either side of the front door. This house is covered with wide lap rustic and also forms the verandah balustrade. Pairs of square posts that are designed to look pegged together by a crosspiece support the main beam across the verandah.
