SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)

This classic one-room schoolhouse was established to service the West Dry Creek Road area, originally known as Pine Flat Road, between 1877 and 1898. Of the simplest construction possible, this school has remained unaltered over the years. This school district was the first rural school in the area to unite with the Healdsburg school district in 1925.

Pine Ridge School is a good example of the schoolhouses which dotted the countryside in Sonoma County during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. A small, one-room schoolhouse, it remains a neighborhood focal point despite its closure in 1936 -- the first school to unionize and to participate in the consolidation of rural schools into the Healdsburg Elementary School District.
